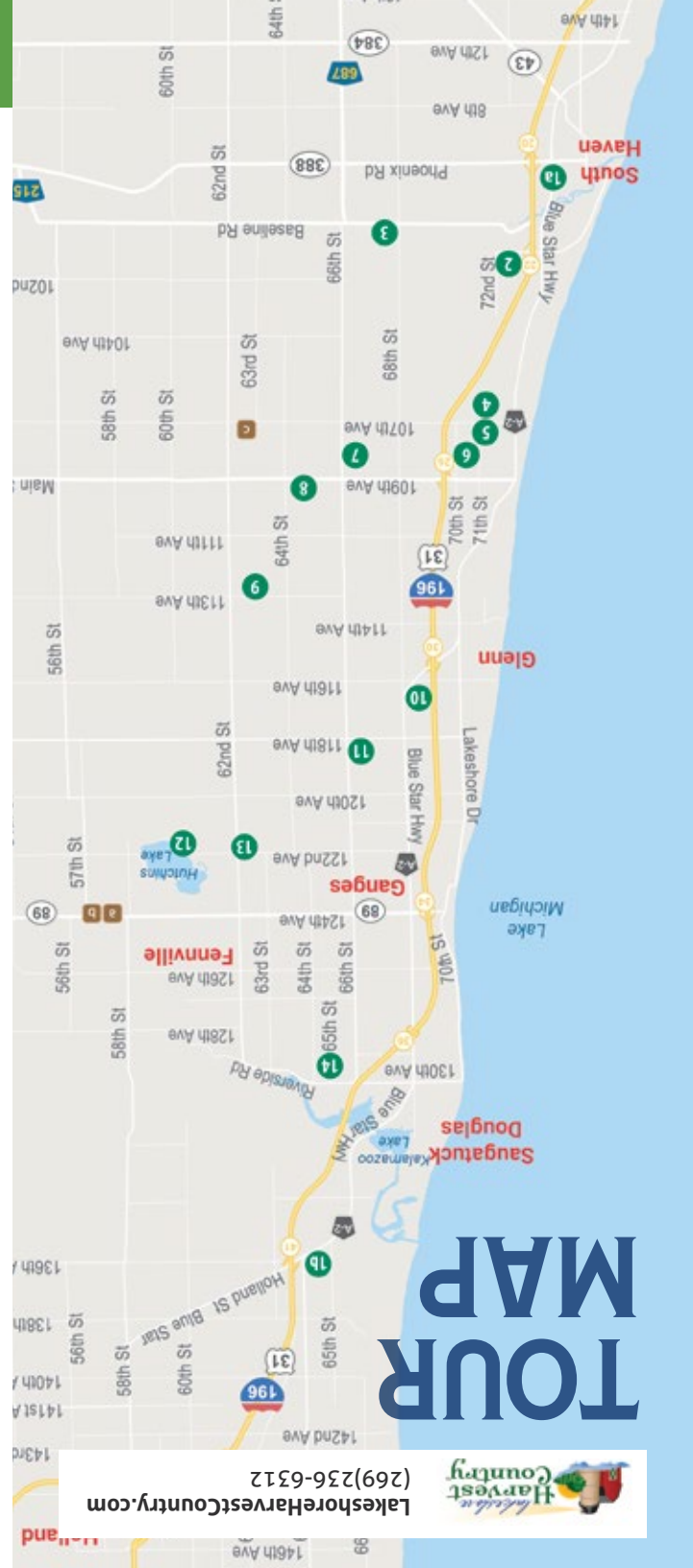

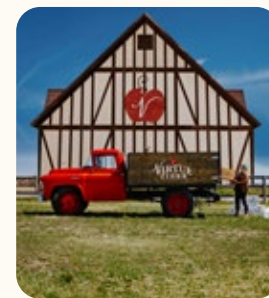


Fenn Valley Vineyards & Winery

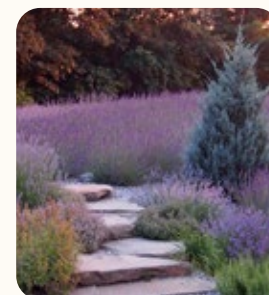
Virtue Cider
